

ABOUT THE SITE

LyondellBasell's Wesseling / Knapsack Sites are located in the Cologne region. The Wesseling site began operation in 1953 and covers 2,7 square kilometers. It is LyondellBasell's largest site in Europe. The plants at the Knapsack site began operation in 1970 and are located in the Chemiepark Knapsack about 10 miles from the Wesseling site. The Wesseling site has its own power plant with a capacity of 470 MW, a wastewater treatment plant and a sewage incineration plant.
