



Tert-Butyl Acetate Solvent Maskant Recommendations

Introduction

Lyondell Chemical Company has evaluated various fragrances to alter the odor of TBAc (t-butyl acetate). Some of the items evaluated will mask the odor while others will provide a fragrance to the TBAc. Please note that our tests did not look at formulated products, but only at the TBAc itself.
