Covering an area of almost 239 acres, LyondellBasell's Clinton Complex is one of the largest chemical plants in Iowa. Using natural gas liquids as a feedstock, the plant manufactures ethylene, the world's most widely-used petrochemical, which is then converted into polyethylene plastic resins. These resins enhance the quality of life by serving as building blocks for products such as leak-proof and shatter-proof containers for industrial and household chemicals, packaging that protects our food from spoilage and contamination, and children's toys that are safe and durable.

## Economic Impact

Our site is a major economic engine for the community by providing skilled jobs, by purchasing millions of dollars in local goods and services and by paying taxes

to support local schools and government services. The Clinton Complex has been an important asset to the community and region for more than 40 years.

## Community Outreach

Site management meets regularly with a panel of residents to discuss the site's environmental and safety performance, community activities, and to discuss community concerns and expectations.

Our employees collectively spend hundreds of hours each month in community service.
